Introduction

The Cuyahoga County Land Reutilization Corporation (CCLRC) is issuing this Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to contract for environmental consulting services in connection with a FY2024 Brownfield Cleanup Grant funded through a Cooperative Agreement with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA). Those interested in being considered must provide a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) no later than 4 p.m. on Thursday, August 15, 2024.

CCLRC will internally evaluate the submitted SOQs. CCLRC may choose to interview top-ranked candidates; final rankings will be determined by the combined results of the SOQ evaluation and the interviews. Thereafter, the CCLRC intends to enter into a contract with the finalist.

Required Minimum Qualifications

Responding individuals or firms must have an Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) Voluntary Action Program (VAP)-Certified Professional (CP) on staff that meets the qualifications under Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-300-05, has a current certificate issued by the Director of OEPA and has documented prior work experience with OEPA's VAP (Ohio Revised Code 3746) and its rules. The individual or firm may not satisfy these requirements by sub-contracting or partnering with others.

MBE/WBE consultants are encouraged to respond to this RFQ.

Project Overview

CCLRC applied for and was selected to receive \$500,000 funding under the USEPA FY 2024 Brownfield Cleanup Grant to address contamination at Parcel Number 006-28-038 owned by CCLRC at 3203 W. 71st St., Cleveland, Ohio.

The 1.277-acre parcel is located on the west side of Cleveland, Ohio in the neighborhood that used to be home to the Stockyards; while the large slaughterhouses have closed, there are still food manufacturing and distributing companies in the area. Census Tract 1027.00 contains roughly 4,074 people; the Median Household Income is \$28,414, with 41.9 percent of the people at poverty levels. Homeownership rate is 31.8 percent. Over a third of the people are of Hispanic or Latino descent.

The site may be used as expansion for the adjacent food manufacturer. Prior assessments indicate that past uses of the site were textile and leather manufacturing, equipment warehousing and chemical manufacturing. These uses have resulted in the recognized environmental conditions of three underground storage tanks and petroleum- and hazardous substance-contaminated soils and groundwater.

The chosen consultant will oversee the remediation of these conditions and generate a No Further Action letter (NFA) in pursuit of a Covenant Not to Sue (CNS) through OEPA's VAP, while participating in the USEPA's Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) Track. The project may take up to three years. The work must be completed under the direction of a VAP-CP and conform to the standards and procedures of VAP and MOA.

The selected individual or firm will be subject to Federal contract requirements including, but not limited to, Minority Business Enterprise/Women's Business Enterprise (MBE/WBE) program, DBE project certification process and minimum Federal (Davis-Bacon) wage rates, where applicable.

Scope of Service

Consultant will provide services including, but not limited to:

(1) Remediation Planning & Preparation

Finalize Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA); create a Remedial Action Plan; develop project health and safety plans; create remediation design plans and specifications for review by OEPA and USEPA; enroll the site in the OEPA VAP using the MOA Track; solicit bids and procure a remediation contractor.

(2) Remediation

Oversee the contractor's removal and disposal of USTs and contaminated soils; oversee contractor's activities and approve all payments; conduct confirmation soil sampling; prepare and complete Bureau of Underground Storage Tanks (BUSTR) closure assessments and VAP and MOA processes, including submitting a request for a VAP NFA and requesting a CNS from OEPA.

(3) Community Outreach

The consultant will participate in six community events or public meetings in conjunction with the CCLRC throughout the project.

(4) Miscellaneous

The selected consultant will be requested to provide and direct all qualified personnel necessary to perform the project activities. In performing these remediation activities, the consultant may be required to:

- 1. Provide and maintain necessary coverage on firm/individual insurance certificates, licenses or other contractual documentation as requested.
- 2. Review all provided materials, including any previously conducted environmental reports prior to preparing a proposal of work.
- Prepare project-specific proposals, which would include a chart showing the names, titles and responsibilities of all personnel to be assigned to the project; a chart showing the fee range for all possible professional services to be conducted along with a detailed budget of cost to be proposed for each task (including subcontractor costs).
- 4. Provide project management, implementation and/or technical oversight as needed.
- 5. Provide professional advice regarding environmental issues associated with land reuse, redevelopment and other related matters.
- 6. Attend public or project-specific meetings with CCLRC staff and/or officials from Federal, State, and local regulatory agencies during remediation projects.
- 7. Communicate with CCLRC staff and other governmental entities regarding project specifics.

Beyond the required minimum qualifications, the Primary Criteria for evaluation are:

I. Identification and Background Information

- 1. Individual or firm's name, business postal address, contact name, telephone and fax numbers, email address.
- 2. Federal I.D. number
- 3. Ohio Tax I.D. number
- 4. The entity's legal form (e.g., corporation, sole proprietor, etc.) and State of incorporation, date of formation, name changes and mergers
- 5. Relevant brochure and promotional materials. Please attach these materials to your submission.

II. Qualifications and Experience

- 1. Provide a concise history of the individual or firm, its main partners/officers and largest shareholder(s).
- 2. Provide a description of up to five cleanup projects managed by the candidate in the previous three years. Include project dates, project titles, community location, employees involved and originally-estimated and final costs.
- 3. Describe your/your firm's experience with managing relevant-scale remediation projects.
- 4. Include a description of your/your firm's resources, including staff, equipment and capital available for project use and deployment. Explain approaches used to control costs on previous projects.
- 5. Provide any additional information that would support selection.
- 6. Provide a list of up to five projects, including the location and a brief description of the project, for which you/your firm has submitted a NFA and successfully received a CNS from OEPA.
- 7. Please identify whether you/your firm has ever submitted a NFA to OEPA for which a CNS was not eventually granted.
- 8. Provide a list of Certified Professionals who, while working for you/your company (even if they are no longer employed by your company) had their certification either threatened with suspension, suspended, or revoked by OEPA.
- 9. Provide a description of your/your firm's experience with and approach to public engagement.

III. Personnel
